It is not only a requirement of Surf Life Saving Australia, but it enables us to see where your child's skills are at, in the water, at the beginning of the season. This means we can adjust our approach with our Water Safety team, individually for each Age Group and each child. Remember, even if your child didn't look and feel confident, they will still be participating in all the activities, we will just be giving them extra support and working on building their skills.

Also, having your child's name clearly written on the front of their Nippers cap helps us identify them and helps Age managers and Assistants and Water Safety get to know their names. It makes the Nippers feel good when we can encourage them and use their names. Some of the Nippers already had this done. It really helped us last Sunday, so thanks for that.
